Class Curriculum

This is a special five day (36 hour) training program designed for **Supervisors in Vice Units, Narcotics Units, Gang Units, Tactical Units and Patrol Divisions** who participate in street level enforcement/tactical and undercover narcotics/vice investigations. All to often supervisors with limited experience are placed into specialized units with little training or no actual experience. This places a huge liability and safety factor on the supervisor, personnel and the agency itself. This is a one of a kind training that will emphasize implementing policies as well as conducting actual specialized operations. The training will detail how to utilize specific units within your own agency in order to cut down on operating expenses and how to conduct more thorough and efficient investigations. Civil liability has become a huge issue in law enforcement. Case studies and techniques that can be implemented to cut down associated risks will be discussed. The conference will also detail narcotics reverse sting operations, street level prostitution investigations, escort agency investigations, long term gang investigations and fraud based gang investigations. Tactical operations and planning will be detailed offering insight on "low risk" versus "high risk" search warrant operations. Mandatory personnel rotation is a popular topic in law enforcement. The pro's and cons of mandatory rotation policies will be discussed. The training will detail how to set up and operate multi agency task forces which are effective in combating crime as well as being very cost effective for the participating agencies. Selection of personnel in specialized units is paramount to their success. Options and selection processes will be discussed to ensure for different units. This conference will offer insight to frontline supervisors, officers who are place in acting supervisory roles as well as command staff personnel.

Steve Cook: Steve is a detective with a law enforcement agency in the Midwest. He is considered to be one of the premier *Outlaw Motorcycle Investigators* in the United States. Mike served in the Narcotics unit for 14 years and worked on a DEA task force as well as a state task force specializing in money laundering and narcotics investigations. Mike has extensive experience in narcotics reverses and long term crack cocaine investigations as well as undercover vice related investigations. Mike participated in numerous long term investigations targeting and prosecuting gang members, narcotics trafficking subjects and money laundering subjects. He has instructed thousands of law enforcement officers from all over the world.

Bob Volguardson: Bob is a detective with the Boca Raton Police Dept. and has over 19 years of law enforcement experience. Bob has spent his entire career in the Special Investigations Division working narcotics and vice related investigations. Bob has participated in numerous undercover vice related investigations as a case agent and in undercover capacities. Bob has written numerous "Sneak and Peak" search warrants for the infiltration of illicit massage parlors which has resulted in RICO arrests and the seizure of millions of dollars. He acted in an undercover capacity in long term investigations and he will discuss the pro's and cons of these investigations as an undercover officer.
